We are in Great Lent from February 15<sup>th</sup> to Holy Pascha on April 4<sup>th</sup>. Each member of our parish community is encouraged to prayerfully prepare for, and then participate in the Sacrament of private Confession. This Sacrament will be offered on all Saturday evenings of Great Lent following Vespers (or after any service), as well as on Sunday mornings, half-an-hour before the Divine Liturgy. There will be no General Confession before Pascha. You can have your private Confession either in our church or in another parish [Orthodox obviously], where your spiritual father is. Private Confession in our parish can be done by appointment as well, at your convenience.
