How do We Enter the Church?

1. When we enter the church, we cover ourselves with the sign of the Cross.
2. We buy and offer candles as a gift to God and a sacrifice for the church. (If the Divine Liturgy is served, we write a list of names of the *Orthodox Christians*, both living and departed, and send it with Proskophora bread into the Altar for prayers during Proskomedia).
3. We venerate (make a sign of the Cross and a bow) before the icon which has been placed on a stand in the middle of the church.
4. We venerate icons of Christ and the Mother of God, which are on the stands in front of the Ambo.
5. We light and place our candles in the candle stands.
